Environmental Awareness

Increase public awareness of the concept of climate resilience and highlight the natural and cultural values of the park through training for young people and guided tours in the Baixa Limia - Xurés Natural Park.

Explanation

Integrate the youth in the conservation of the natural and cultural heritage values of the Natural Park is key to improve the resilience against risks and climate change.

Result

More than 350 young people from 7 institutes visited the Natural Park. The students were picked up by bus from their centers and transferred to the Interpretation Center of the Natural Park. They participated in talks about the cultural and natural values of the protected natural area. The risks that it faces and the actions that are being carried out for its conservation and improvement of resilience were exposed.

In addition to the training, the students enjoyed the town and went on a guided tour along the Vilameá River. In this tributary of the Limia River they visited its waterfalls and had the opportunity to see some of the cultural heritage items of the Natural Park, such as the Roman baths and 12 mills.
